My wife Janice prided herself on always being there for our three sons, as they were no doubt the most important people to her in the world. Her love for them was demonstrated in many ways, but in particular by never missing our sons' musical events.

Eleven years ago, we were all shocked when Janice skipped a concert because she wasn't feeling well. The next morning there was clearly something wrong as she was extremely bloated and struggling to breath. We rushed her to the hospital, hoping for a harmless gastrointestinal diagnosis.

Unfortunately, it was much worse than any of us ever imagined. Much of what happened after she was admitted is a complete blur, but what I do remember is feeling my world crashing down around me as my best friend, my wife of 30 years, and the mother to our sons was given just a few months to live.

Janice was never one to go down without a fight and while she ultimately lost her battle to ovarian cancer, she survived almost four years and was blessed to see the birth of her fourth grandchild. At just 59 years old, Janice was taken from her family and friends much too early, leaving a gaping hole in all our lives.

As tragic as our story is, my wife and I always believed even the worst situations can be turned into opportunity for change. My sons and I have done just that by creating the Janice Lopez Ovarian Cancer Foundation (JLOCF), a locally focused and volunteer run 501(c)(3) nonprofit.

Since our inception, we have raised over \$100,000 to support ovarian cancer research, education, awareness and patients. Our premiere fundraising event this year is the "Teal Night for Life"; a fun-filled evening featuring the dueling piano musical group, "The Flying Ivories". They will belt out an all-request singalong where guests can dance, sing and even join the performers on stage. The event will also include cocktails, pub food, and a silent auction which will include many unique prizes.

This year's "Teal Night for Life" will be held on the Rutgers Campus - across from the Olive Branch Bar & Restaurant in New Brunswick. Please join us for a fun evening to fight ovarian cancer. Together, we can help save the lives of our mothers, daughters, sisters and friends.
